

## **General Recommendations and requirements:**

### **Items to have inside vehicle:**

- (1) Fire extinguisher – (mounted and charged) – check charge annually
- (3) Emergency triangles
- Spare fuses
- Letter from company authorizing employee passengers when applicable (this is not a requirement in the vehicle, but it will save you possible violations during a roadside inspection.
- Current registration (truck & trailer)
- Current Insurance card (truck & trailer)
- Copy of Annual Inspection for truck & trailer (only a sticker attached to vehicle & trailer or copies in the cab is required but having both is a good practice)
- Copy of UCR Registration (if applicable) –
- Emergency Response Kit – (including camera, directions & policies)
- Each State will require different forms to be carried in the vehicles depending on your specific operations... please contact your state to verify you include everything needed in each cab book.

### **Items that driver will need to carry:**

- Current drivers License
- DOT Medical Card – (although states are now including medical info on Driver's License it is still recommended that drivers carry a copy at all times)
- Current Log book (when applicable – Includes certain pick-ups when weight exceeds 10,001 lbs or combined 26,001 lbs)
